With these children two things are important: Firstly their family has to accept that the child has a handicap and secondly society has to agree that these children need special schools.

In these schools the children can be taught how to live their own lives; this is called learning social skills. They learn how to do simple things like find their own clothes, dress themselves, hold a paintbrush. The lessons are not like those in other schools. Students may make a shop as part of a lesson in order to learn about money and how to count. Many parents think that after a few years their child will get better.
