It is a little known fact that 1 child in every 100 is born with a heart defect. Most of these physical defects can be corrected by operations which are performed in the developed world. In contrast, if uncorrected, these defects can cause a lot of suffering and sometimes premature death, So the Chain of Hope was created to help as many of these children as possible.

The children who are cared for by the Chain of Hope come from countries which suffer from poverty or **conflicts**. They are children who have been born with deformities, who have caught diseases or who suffer from of injuries. A very simple operation can often save them. But their own countries can't afford such surgeries, owing to not having specialized experience and technical resources.

"Faced with this terrible fact," says Professor Alan, a heart surgeon, " We had a simple idea : to bring these children to France, to provide them with operations, and then send them home, cured, to their families. or help develop local medical services by sending teams of surgeons to their countries."

"To achieve **this**" , continues Professor Alan, " The Chain of Hope simply needs a series of links in a chain of skills, asking people with all types of experience to take part. Everyone can participate and become a link in the chain."

And so, well-known surgeons, the most highly skilled in their fields, operate free of charge in their hospitals throughout France. Similarly, ambulances provide the children with free transport, and the airlines Air France offer free tickets. At the end of the chain, one finds a network of families who host the children during their recuperation.
